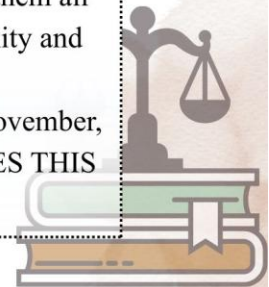
JUSTICE, social, economic and political;
