Ambedkar, the principal architect of the Constitution.

- **Constitutional Procedures** – Amendment process, emergency provisions, and legislative functioning.
- **Important Amendments** – Notable changes such as the **44th Amendment**.

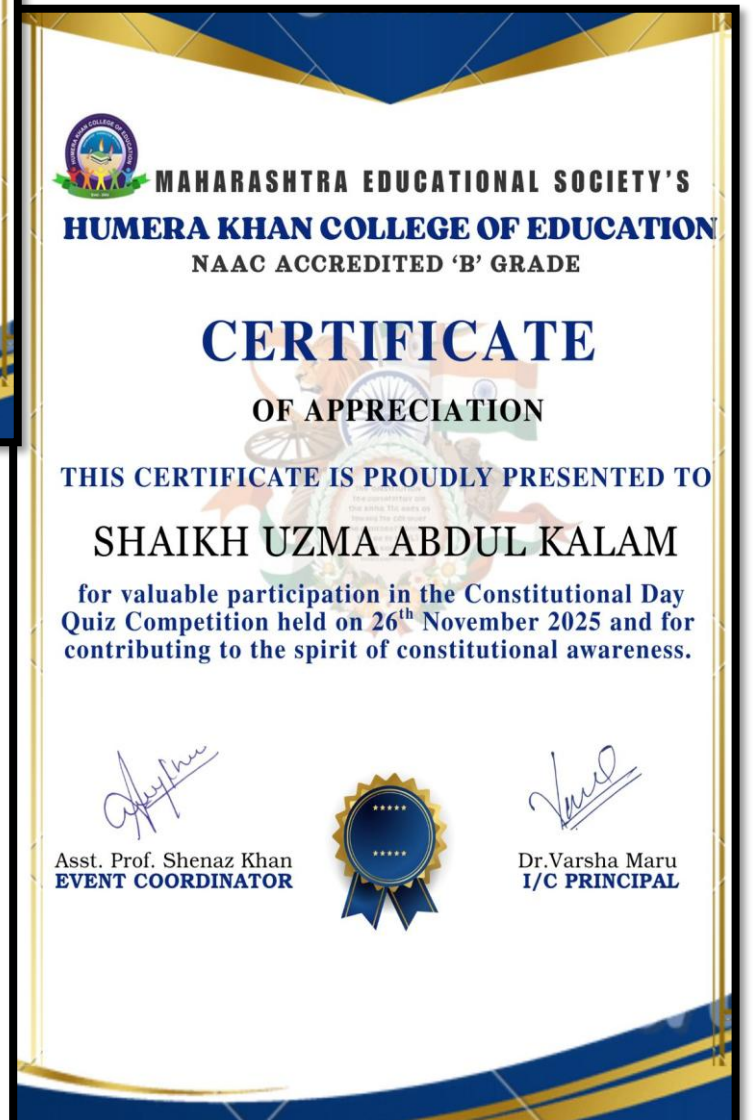
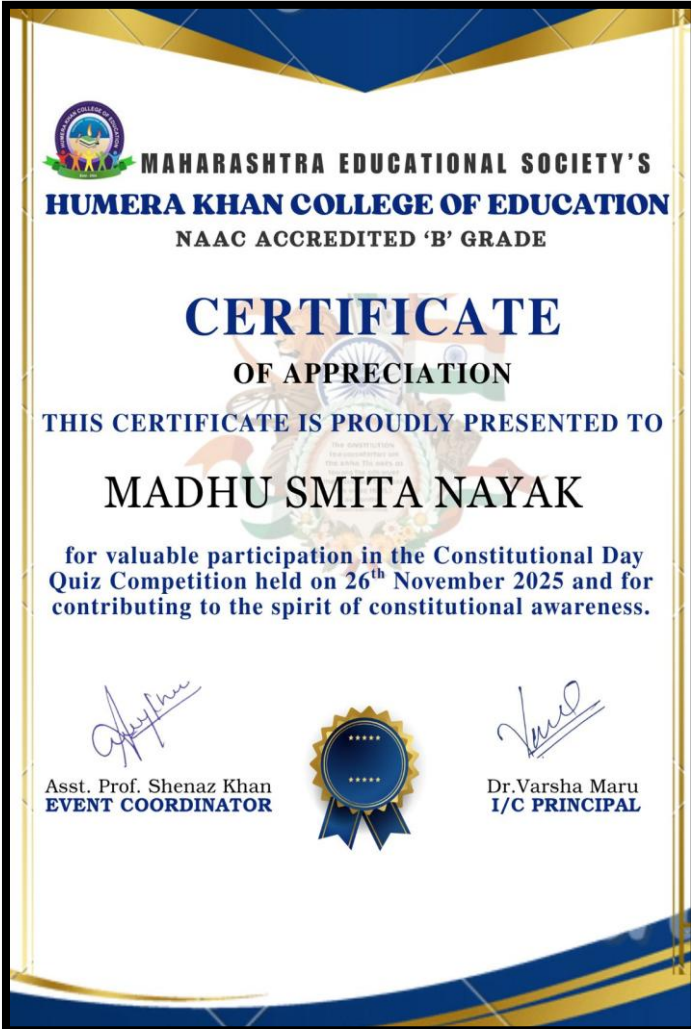
