Outcome

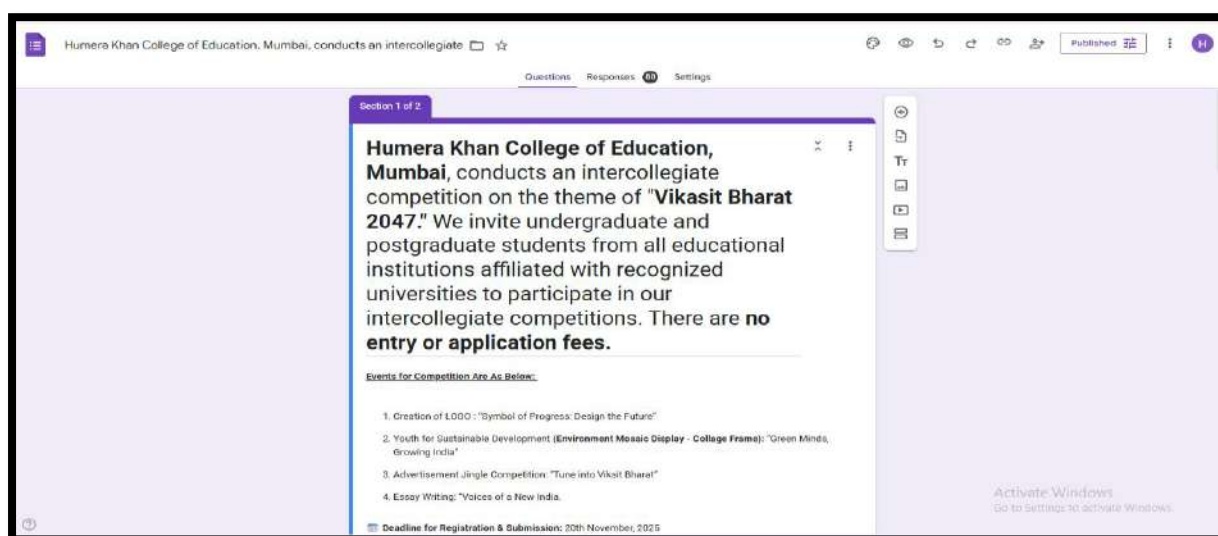
