A total of 17 students from Humera Khan College of Education, accompanied by Dr. Avani Kanakia Ma'am (Extension Work Teacher), participated enthusiastically in this inter-collegiate DLLE festival. The event provided a vibrant platform for students to showcase their talents in various competitions such as Street Play, Creative Writing, Elocution, and Poster Making. The festival aimed to strengthen experiential learning and encourage students to express social, cultural, and educational perspectives through creative means.

SIGNIFICANCE

Such extension activities bridge the gap between theoretical learning and practical exposure. They help future educators understand the importance of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities in shaping well-rounded individuals.

The event also strengthened interpersonal skills, promoted discipline, time management, and instilled confidence among students. Moreover, engaging in creative and performative

activities nurtures empathy, social responsibility, and cultural sensitivity essential qualities for aspiring teachers. The guidance of faculty members and interaction with students from different institutions further enriched the learning experience.

CONTENT

The group of 17 students from Humera Khan College of Education, along with Dr. Avani Kanakia Ma'am, reached DTSS College of Commerce in the morning. Registration commenced at 8:30 a.m., after which participants were provided breakfast arrangements by the host college.

The event formally began at 9:30 a.m. with an inauguration ceremony held at the auditorium. During this session, participating colleges were allotted their respective college codes. 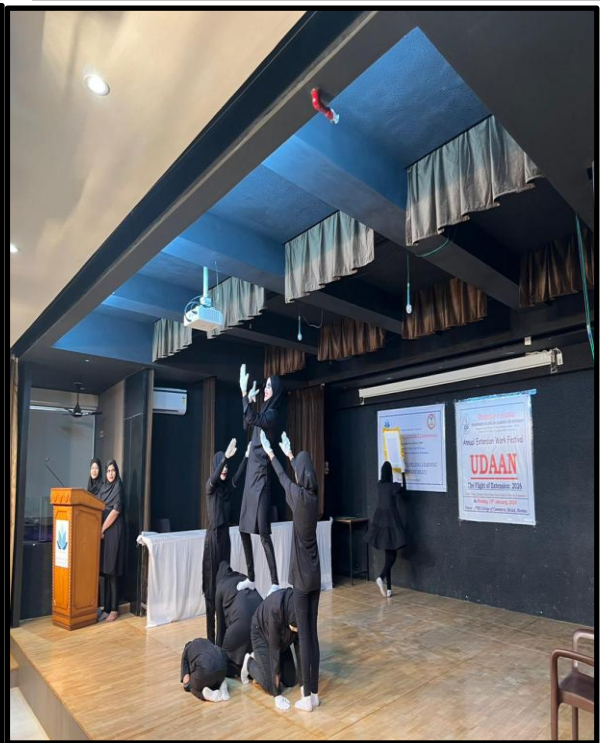

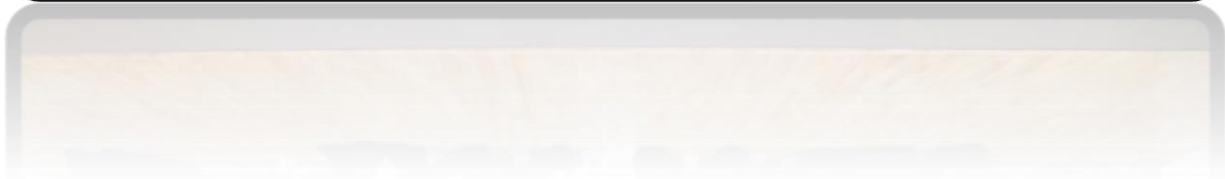
