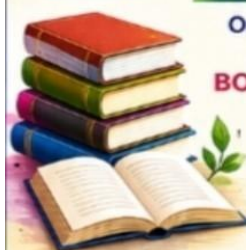

REPORT ON NATIONAL LIBRARIAN'S DAY AND BOOK EXHIBITION
